Competition cancellation- Refund excluding competition expenses. USEA Starter and D&M Fees Refund Policy: The USEA Starter and D&M fees (\$21), are not subjected to office fees, and shall be returned within 30 days of the competition to any rider who does not start the dressage test.

Entries:

Preliminary entries must include copies of USEF membership cards for rider, trainer, and owner.

Entry fees include a \$25 non-refundable office fee. Double entries: Not accepted.

USEA membership/registration requirements effective December 1, 2017 for Beginner Novice. This level will no longer have the option to pay a \$25 non-member fee: riders must be a current Junior, Full, Life or Collegiate member and horses registered with either a Limited status or Full.

\$50 returned check fee. \$25 fee for lost pinny. Pinny fee will be billed after the event.

There will be an **Express Check In** line for competitors who have submitted **complete** entries.

Neg. Coggins within 12 months required for all horses (include copy with entry) & 30 day health certificate required (for horses arriving from out of the state of Missouri only) within 30 days to be presented to show secretary upon arrival.

MCPC is also offering a Starter level horse trial AND a Starter level Combined Test (Dressage and Show Jumping). USEA membership is not required for Starter level. Starter participants are exempt from the USEA Starter/D&M Fee and USEA Membership/Non-Membership Fees are waived. Starter Division Dressage Test = USDF Intro Test B for both horse trial and combined test. To enter Starter Combined Test, please use the USEA Entry Form and note "Combined Test" at the top. CT entries will be accepted thru closing date.

Cross-Country:

P-2900 m @ 520 mpm, confidence building course for horses prepared for the level. Terrain questions test balance. **T**-2500 m @ 450 mpm, solid course for level; forward galloping track with use of terrain to balance and educate. **N**-2200 m @ 400 mpm; inviting track for horses with some experience at the level. **BN**- 2000 m @ 350 mpm; inviting track for horses with some experience at the level. **Starter Division** 1300 m @ 275 mpm with 10-11 inviting obstacles (max height 2'3").

All courses: Varied terrain; gently rolling hills with excellent galloping tracks. Expect water, banks and ditches at all levels. Appropriate courses for spring event. Cross country course officially closed effective 6:00 pm Saturday, 4/15/17 until course walk on 5/12/17.

Cross-country course officially closed 6:00 Saturday, 4/15/17 until course walk at 3:00 pm on 5/12/17.
